

## **SINGAPORE UNIVERSITY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES SCHOLARSHIP**

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS) Scholarship is open to all new and current part-time undergraduate students except Law students.
2. Applicants must be Singapore citizens or permanent residents with good academic and co-curricular activities record, strong language skills and demonstrate leadership qualities.
3. The value of the scholarship covers 100% (inclusive of government subsidy) of the total course fee. Scholarship recipients are not required to serve a bond with the University.
4. Applicants must meet the admission requirements for the applied course of study. Prospective students must separately seek admission to the programme and must be accepted for admission before being awarded the scholarship.
5. Prospective students must separately submit the online Admission Application with supporting documents and S\$64.20 (inclusive of GST) application fee (non-refundable) to the University.
6. Applicants are allowed to apply for only one scholarship or sponsorship at any one time.
7. The scholarship may not, without the prior approval of the University, be held concurrently with any other awards.
8. The recipient is required to sit for all examinations, complete the programme within the prescribed time and conform to regulations, instructions and discipline in force for the respective programme. In addition, the recipient must maintain at least a cumulative Grade Point Average of 4.0 for the continuation of the scholarship award.
9. The University reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the scholarship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct or academic performance has not been satisfactory.
10. The University reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions for the scholarship award at its sole discretion.

11. Applicants are required to submit copies of educational certificates, transcripts, pay slip and other supporting documents together with the scholarship application. Otherwise, the application would be considered incomplete and will not be processed.
12. Scholarship application for **January semester / July semester** must be submitted by **30 September / 31 March** respectively. Recipients are not allowed to request for deferment of the scholarship award.
13. Shortlisted applicants will be notified to attend an interview by **end October for January semester** and **end April for July semester**. **The decision of the University on the selection of scholarship candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.**

A separate letter and agreement with the detailed terms and conditions (including the above terms and conditions) and others relating to the course of study will be given to all successful applicants.
